

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED
UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE APPROVING THE
SHERIFF'S AND DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S
MILITARY EQUIPMENT USE POLICIES**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Orange County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on a proposed uncodified ordinance approving the Sheriff's and District Attorney's military equipment use policies as required by Assembly Bill 481.

DATE OF HEARING: May 24, 2022 and June 7, 2022

TIME OF HEARING: 9:30 a.m. or as soon thereafter as possible.

LOCATION OF HEARING: Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Hall of Administration, 333 W. Santa Ana Blvd., Bldg. 10, Civic Center Plaza (northwest corner of Broadway and Santa Ana Blvd.), Santa Ana, California 92701.

PROPOSAL: On behalf of the Sheriff and District Attorney, the Office of County Counsel will request that the Board of Supervisors conduct a public hearing on a proposed uncodified ordinance, and adopt the ordinance, approving the Sheriff's and the District Attorney's military equipment use policies as required by Assembly Bill 481. The policies are required to address a number of specific topics, including the type, quantity, capabilities, purposes and authorized uses of each type of equipment, the fiscal impact of their acquisition and use, the legal and procedural rules that govern their use, the training required by any officer allowed to use them, the mechanisms in place to ensure policy compliance, and the procedures by which the public may register complaints. If the Board takes the action recommended for May 24, 2022, then on June 7, 2022, County Counsel will request the Board adopt the ordinance.

INVITATION TO BE HEARD: All persons, including those favoring or opposing this proposal, are invited to present their views before the Board of Supervisors.
